



# Site Rules



No open fires or disposable BBQs.

Remove dirty shoes before entering the buildings.



Be considerate of nearby houses. We have a late noise curfew of 10pm.



Help us keep the site clean by putting rubbish in the bins. Black bin bags can be collected from Info Point. Report full bins to Volunteer & Info Point.



Clean up spills yourself if possible. There are cleaning stations with supplies, or ask at the Volunteer & Info Point.



## First Aid

## Safety

We have security guards on the main entrance and patrolling the site 24 hours a day.

## Pass & ticket

Your pass is your proof of payment. You need to wear it at all times. If you lose your pass, you will have to pay again.



## **Child Safety**

We take the care of young and vulnerable people seriously. If you wish to read our safeguarding policy, or speak to our Safeguarding Lead, please ask at Reg Desk. Lost children should make their way to Reg Desk or a Security Guard.

Ultimately, your children are your responsibility so please supervise them at all times, including whilst in workshops.

If you struggle to queue for long periods of time, or need separate or supported access to a show, please go to Reg Desk 30 minutes before a show starts.

(Technology willing) you will have the option to watch the main shows at a location (TBC) separate to the main show venue. Check at Reg Desk for confirmation & location.

# Toilets & Showers




There are no accessible toilets inside. Every portable toilet block (outside) marked on the map includes accessible toilets.

BJC is run by jugglers, for jugglers, so we really appreciate all of your help. Even our crew are all volunteers!


